There is so much noise in our culture today. People desperately clamoring to be heard, to be right, to be vindicated. The 24-hour news cycle and social media make everyone an expert and everyone a victim. How does the follower of Jesus maneuver through all of this white noise? How do we glorify God, love our neighbor, and tell others about Jesus?

I believe the Word of God tells us in 1 Corinthians, chapter one, that we have to lay aside our desire to be recognized as right. We must abandon our search for approval or respect from the culture. We must never play the victim. The Apostle Paul tells us, "For the Word of the cross is folly to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God." (1 Cor. 1:18) We do not seek glory, wisdom, or grace from the surrounding culture. We glory in the cross. We are fools for Christ.

Paul goes on to say, "God chose what is low and despised in the world, even things that are not, to bring to nothing things that are, so that no human being might boast in the presence of God." (1 Cor. 1:28-29) We the church of the Living God are nothing, but in Jesus we possess everything. How do we glorify God? We seek Him above any other thing or person. How do we love our neighbor? We lay aside our crusade for self and in humility put others first. How do we tell others about Jesus? We abandon the wisdom of the world and proclaim the foolishness of the cross. We risk our reputation as "respectable" people to become fools for Jesus. No one said this would be easy. But in obedience there is the joy of the Lord.

Some activities will be taking a break for summer


As usual, with many members taking summer vacations and involved in summer activities, many of our winter term activities will take a break before resuming in the fall.
